بَارَكَ اللهُ لَكَ وَبَارَكَ عَلَيْكَ، وَجَمَعَ
بَيْنَكُمَا فِي خَيْرٍ

(أبو داود، ترمذی، مسند أحمد)

Transliteration

Bārakallāhu laka wa bāraka ‘alayk, wa jama‘a baynakumā fi khayr.

Translation

May Allāh grant you blessings and may He shower His blessings upon you and may He make your union blessed. (Abū Dāwūd, At-Tirmidhī, Musnad Aḥmad)
